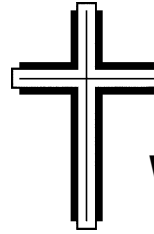

Stewardship Thought: *"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."* Matthew 5:3
