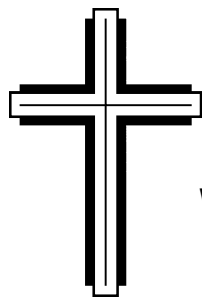

As humans, it is natural for us to compare ourselves with others, but today, Jesus’ message is that we should be grateful for what we’ve been given. Perhaps like the laborer, we can be a little more grateful for the gifts God has given us instead of comparing ourselves with others.

Catholics Care, Catholics Vote: In their statement on *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship*, the U.S. Catholic bishops lift up various issues of different moral weight and urgency. Some issues they mention include: addressing abortion, euthanasia, racism, the use of the death penalty and imprudent resort to war; protecting the fundamental understanding of marriage as the life-long and faithful union of one man and one woman; achieving comprehensive immigration reform; caring for our common home; helping families and children overcome poverty; providing healthcare while respecting human life, human dignity and religious freedom; and establishing and complying with moral limits on the use of military force. Learning Opportunities for Adults: Adults seeking to learn more or deepen their understanding of topics in faith and Catholic Church practice can take advantage of new online opportunities provided by the Office of Religious Education of the Catholic Diocese of Youngstown. Fall courses include “Catholic Belief and Tradition,” led by Sister Joyce Candidi, OSHJ; “Living Catholic Morality,” led by Father Ken Miller; and “The Letter James: Pearls for Wise Living,” led by Sister Therese Ann Rich, OSU. Other course topics include Celebrating Mary Through the Year, Celebrating Catholic Customs and Traditions, Sowing God’s Word, and Living the Sacraments. During Advent, lifelong learners can explore seasonally based scripture courses. These online sessions allow flexibility in schedules, because learners can read, reflect, and respond at any time of the day. Materials are provided and assignments posted at the beginning of a given week, and participants have the week to respond, until the following week’s learning is posted. Different courses vary in the number of weeks, from three to ten. Courses fees vary depending on costs of materials and length of time.
