Our gatherings embrace spirituality in prayer, music, scripture reading and fellowship, all in a welcoming and warm environment. It is through our actions that we can share God's unconditional love and support to each other. Kolbe Gathering can help those who are in need and looking for a parish or faith-based organizations to join. Our initial gatherings take place on the first and third Thursday of the month from 6:00 until 8:00 p.m. at Holy Apostle SS Peter and Paul Church, 421 Covington Street in Youngstown. During the pandemic, we will adhere to social distancing and masks as needed. The Kolbe Gathering takes its name from the Saint Maximilian Kolbe, the Patron Saint for prisoners and drug addicts.
