ST. COLUMBA CATHEDRAL ORGAN SERIES



Ralph Holzhauser is primarily known as a liturgical musician and a composer. He began his 23 year playing career at four different churches in Northeast Ohio before he was even out of high school, reaching his current position as Diocesan Music Director of Youngstown and the Music Director of the Cathedral of St. Columba in 2022. He has also ventured into the realm of jazz, playing with three time Grammy winner Graham Breedlove at the Kennedy Center, as well as progressive rock, recording at the First Congregational Church of LA, home to the largest church organ in the world. He recently earned his master's degree from world renowned organist Todd Wilson at the Cleveland Institute of Music. Most recently, Mr. Holtzhauser has been asked to be the Professor of Sacred Music at the Franciscan University of Steubenville and the Professor of Organ Performance at Youngstown State University. Mr. Holtzhauser is currently recording a CD of all African American organ music that has yet to be recorded, releasing this upcoming summer and featured at the AGO National Convention.

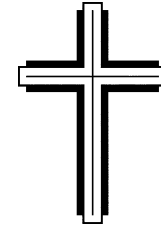
