**Two Proposed Amendments to Ohio' Constitution – Please Do Not Get Them Confused!** At the end of February the Catholic Bishops of Ohio jointly issued a letter in which they warn Catholics and all people of good will that "In Ohio, the dignity of life in its earliest stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to Ohio's Constitution for the November 2023 ballot that would enshrine and expand abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women" and they encourage us to vote against this amendment. In the meantime, another amendment to the Ohio Constitution is being proposed in a special election on August 8: Issue One, which would "require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." Our Ohio Catholic Bishops have taken a neutral stance on Issue One on the August ballot since it does not have any direct moral content. To summarize, while the Catholic Bishops of Ohio are encouraging us to vote NO on the abortion amendment on the November ballot, they are not taking a position one way or another on Issue One on the upcoming August ballot.

**EdChoice Scholarship:** As a result of Ohio House Bill 33, signed into law on July 4, 2023, all K-12 students in Ohio are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic school tuition beginning with the upcoming 2023-2024 school year. This includes currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic school experience this fall. The EdChoice Scholarship will cover a portion, or in some cases, the full cost of a family's Catholic school tuition. A student's specific EdChoice amount depends on the family's 2022 gross adjusted income and family size. The amount could be as much as \$6,165 per year for a student in grades K-8 and \$8,407 per year for a student in grades 9-12. Please contact your local Catholic school to learn how to apply for this benefit. Returning families are already aware of the value of Catholic education. Families interested in pursuing a Catholic education for the first time should contact the local Catholic school principal who will be happy to assist you. Availability for new enrollments will vary by locations.
