The in-person event will take place on Saturday, October 2, 2021 at the Ursuline Center, 4280 Shields, Road, Canfield. The entry fee is \$25 in advance or \$30 the day of the race. *In order to be guaranteed a t-shirt, entry must be received by **Wednesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>**.* There is no entry fee for the Kids' Run.
