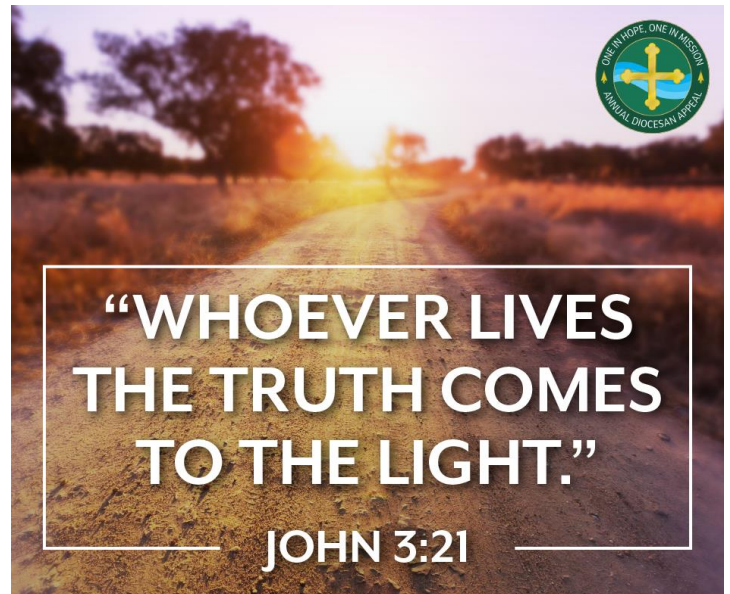
**MARCH 29, 2024**

Your support helps the Church to minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools, offer religious education, and undertake social and charitable works.

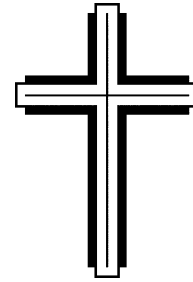

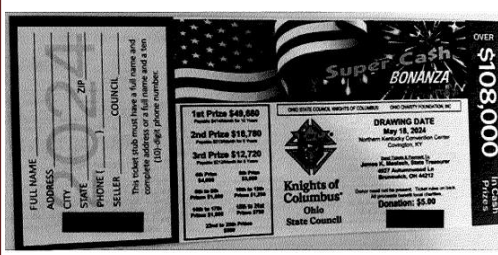
