The Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines.

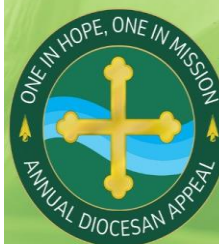
